



MAKASSAR EBONY DATA SHEET

Botanical name: Diospyros Celebica

Country of origin: Asia

Veneer thickness: from 0.5 to 2 mm

Specific gravity: 1200-1250 kg/m³ (air-dried)

Use: given its particularly decorative characteristics and value, it is used for luxury furniture, interior furnishings and wall-coverings. In cabinet-making for carvings and decorative items and for particular musical instruments.

Characteristics: the sapwood is wide with shades ranging from whitish to reddishbrown. The heartwood is very dark, tending to black, crossed by many very marked regular and irregular light streaks, which give the wood a unique, extremely beautiful and decorative appearance.

Drying: drying must be done slowly to avoid tearing.

Surface: the wood is very heavy but has a fine surface structure. Particularly suitable for polishing.

Gluing: glue joints do not create any particular difficulties, unlike nail joints.
