

## MANSONIA DATA SHEET

Botanical name: Mansonia Altissima

Country of origin: Africa

Veneer thickness: from 0.6 to 2 mm

**Specific gravity:** 600-700 kg/m<sup>3</sup> (air-dried)

**Use**: mostly used for furniture and interior furnishings. Sometimes it used as a substitute for Walnut.

**Characteristics**: sapwood yellowish, almost white, narrow. The heartwood tends to be yellowish brown or greyish.

**Drying**: rather easy to dry.

**Surface**: grain is generally straight, sometimes intertwined. Fine to medium and uniform texture, with a slight natural sheen. During sanding, produces dust that often causes skin irritation.

**Gluing**: both types of joints are easy to make.
